DID YOU KNOW???

- **☑** Over 60% of the instructors at City College are part-timers.
- ☑Over 55% of the part-timers at City College want a full-time teaching position but can't get one.
- Part-timers everywhere <u>receive less pay and benefits</u> for doing the same work as full-timers.
- ☑ Part-timers who are lucky enough to receive retirement benefits receive inequitable payment.
- Many part-timers become "freeway flyers" because they must teach at two or more colleges to support themselves or their families.
- Many part-timers routinely apply for <u>unemployment benefits</u> between semesters because they have no guarantee of being hired again and because they need the money.
- ☑ Many part-timers have no office space and receive no pay for office hours.

DID YOU KNOW???

- Campus Equity Week is being promoted throughout the United States and Canada to raise awareness of the poor pay and working conditions of part-time and non-tenure track faculty.
- For the first time ever, Governor Davis included \$57 million in this year's budget to begin improving the salaries of the more than 30,000 part-time faculty in California's community colleges. CCSF's Chancellor Day helped lobby for these funds.
- YOU can help by writing to Governor Davis and asking him to increase next year's budget for part-timer equity.
